Locks in the Kentucky River will be operational during this event. Any waters posted Off-Limits or No Fishing by State or Federal Agencies will be Off-Limits. Any live-bass-release areas established by the Tournament Director

will be Off-Limits as well as any other areas announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.
